Readers bring information from what they already know, and connect it with what they are reading. This helps a reader understand the text better, and remember what they have read.



There are 3 different types of connections readers make:

1. Text to Self
2. Text to World
3. Text to Text

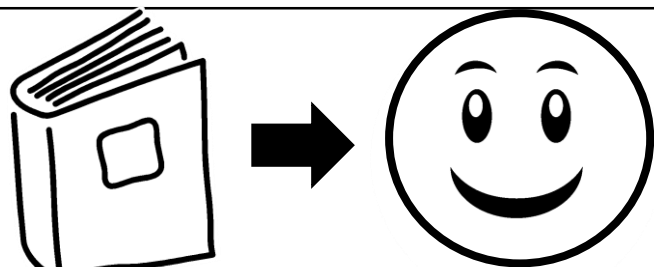
While you are reading, ask yourself these questions:

- How can this connection help me understand what I am reading?

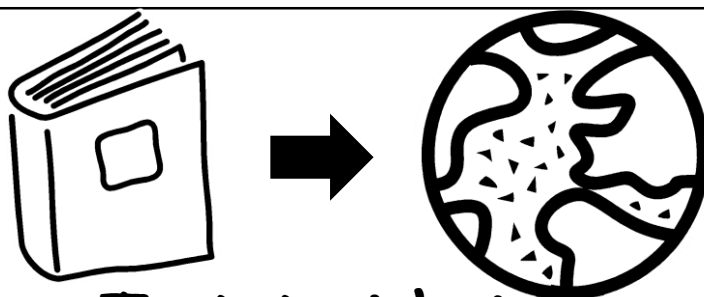

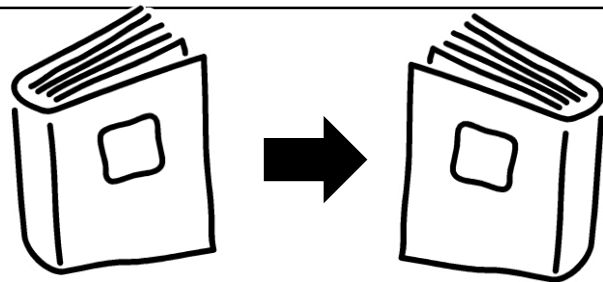
